**PART 1: GENERAL**

**1-1 Description:**

The work of this contract consists of the replacement of floor finishes and upgrades to public restrooms at the Petersburg National Battlefield Visitor Center.

Work to be performed includes: the replacement of glue down carpet; replacement of vinyl cove base trim; the demolition and removal of tile and sheet flooring containing asbestos; replacement of composition tile and other sheet flooring with ceramic; replacement of plumbing fixtures, restroom partitions and restroom accessories. Work also includes minor repairs to restroom ceramic wall tile and the repair and cleaning of grout.

Work is confined to the first floor / lower level only. The contractor shall provide all necessary temporary controls needed to facilitate the work such as temporary storage, portable toilets, signage and barricades.

All work will be performed under a single contract. All materials, used in the completion of this contract shall be contractor-furnished from outside the park.

**1-2 Location:**

The location of the work to be performed is at the Petersburg National Battlefield Visitor Center, 5001 Siege Road, Petersburg, VA 23803

**1-3 Contractor's Use of Premises:**

- A. Construction Camp:** Establishment of a camp within the park will not be permitted. Confine all materials to an area designated by Contracting Officers Technical Representative - (COTR).
- B. HOURS OF OPERATION:** The contractor's normal working hours shall be confined to 7:30 am and 5:00 pm - Monday through Friday. No work will take place on weekends or on official government holidays. Contractor may only work additional hours Monday through Thursday on a case by case basis with a 24 hour notice to the COTR or Facility Manager and must leave the premises by 9:00 pm.
- C.** The first floor work site will be closed to the public during construction. The second floor shall remain open to the public. Contractor shall schedule work so as to maintain access to a minimum of one staff office area for administrative and other official business through out the construction phase.
- D. TRASH AT JOBSITE:** All trash shall be cleaned up daily, at the end of each workday and placed in an area designated by COTR.

- E. Preservation of Natural Features: Confine all operations to work limits of the project. Prevent damage to natural surroundings. Restore damaged areas, repairing or replacing damaged trees and plants, at no additional expense to the Government.
1. Provide temporary barriers to protect existing trees and plants and root zones.
  2. Do not remove, injure, or destroy trees or other plants without prior approval. Consult with COTR and remove agreed-on roots and/or branches that interfere with construction.
  3. Do not fasten ropes, cables, or guys to existing trees.
  4. Carefully supervise excavating, grading, filling, and other construction operations near trees to prevent damage.
- F. BARRICADES, WARNING SIGNS: The contractor will provide, maintain, and erect all necessary barricades, warning signs, and take all precautions to protect the work performed and the safety of the public.

1-4 Field Verification:

Field verify all new and existing dimensions affecting the work of this contract before ordering products. Before submitting a bid for work, the contractor will be held to have examined the site and satisfied themselves of the conditions under which the contractor will be pledged to operate or that, in any manner will affect the work under this contract.

1-5 Contractor Furnished Items:

Contractor will provide all labor, materials and supervision for the completion of work specified.

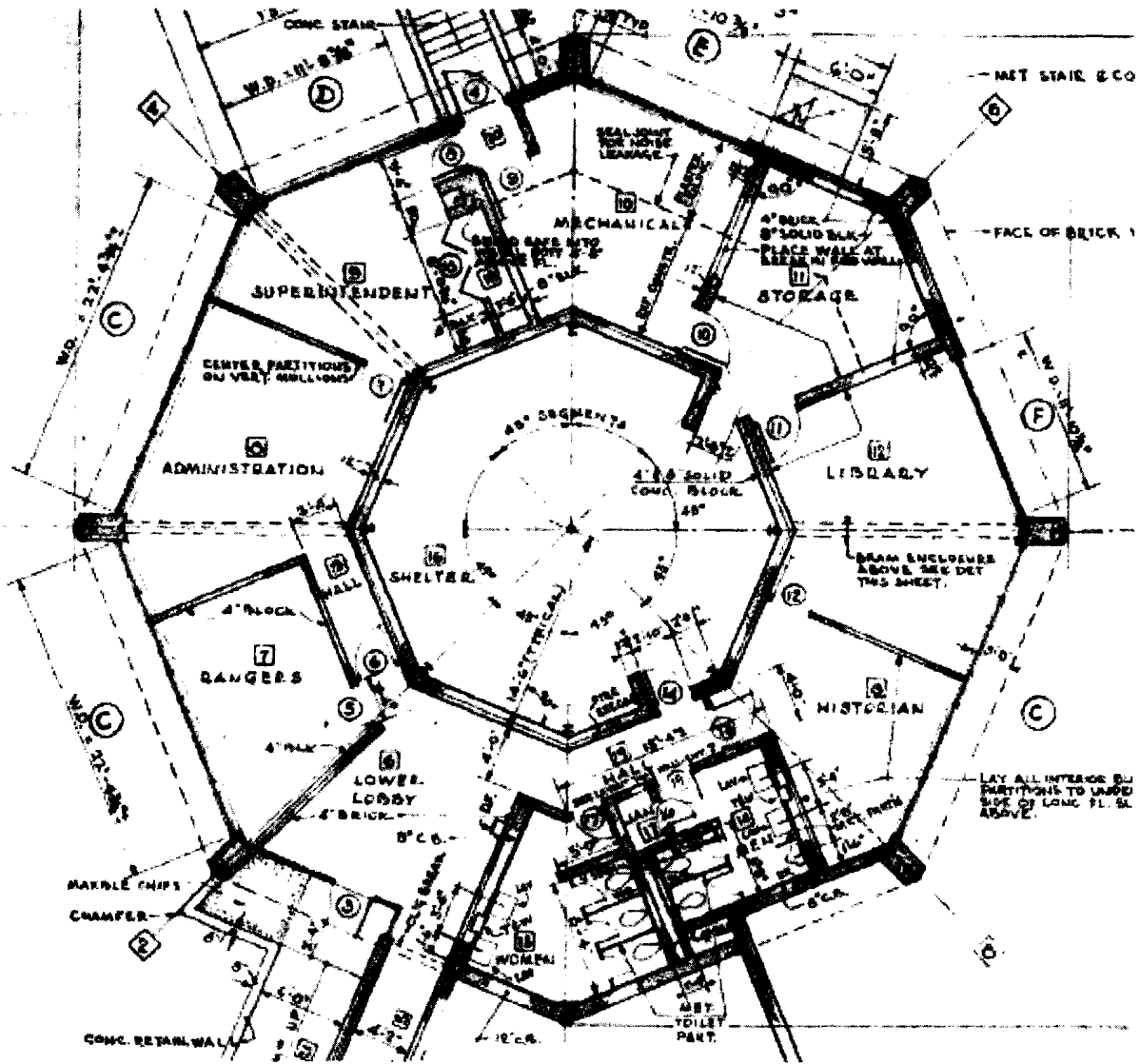
1-6 Commencement, Prosecution, & Completion:

The contractor shall commence work within 10 working days after receipt of the Notification to Proceed and will prosecute the work with faithfulness and energy, and in a neat and orderly manner so as to **complete the work under this contract within 120 calendar days.**

1-7 Pre Construction Conference:

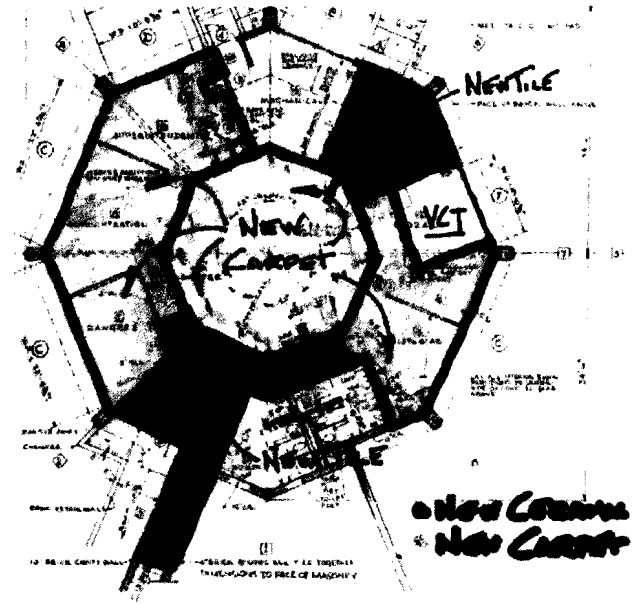
Before any work begins, the Contracting Officer will arrange a meeting at the job site or by conference call to review the work in general. Topics of discussion will be a review of the specifications, safety, administrative duties, submittal requirements, public access, National Park Service policy, regulations, and any questions that the contractor has. If there are no questions concerning the specifications, It will be concluded that there will be no further disagreement with the specifications and drawings, and that work can begin without delay. Any discrepancies not resolved at this meeting, will be resolved before any work begins.

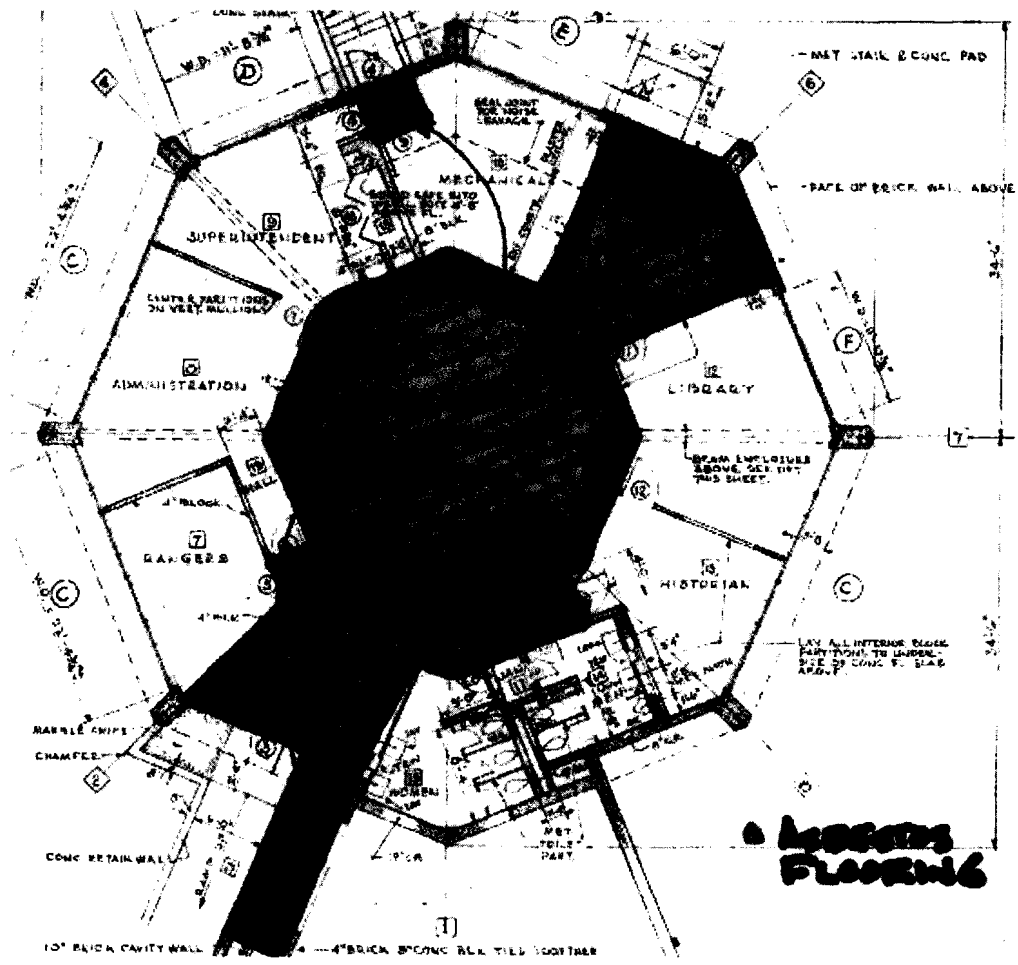


